2. Introduction, Context Analysis, and Contribution to Government Efforts.

This proposal seeks donor support for the construction of Triple Anointing Junior School—a fully operational, inclusive, and child-centred primary school in Nkumba Bufulu, Katabi Town Council, Wakiso District, Uganda. Managed by Triple Anointing Foundation, a non-government organisation, the school provides quality education to orphans and children from low-income households in the underserved communities of Entebbe. The school serves learners from Baby Class (Early Childhood Development) to Primary Seven. The project aims to meet the rising demand for early childhood and primary education in Entebbe, driven by population growth, increased pressure on public schools, and existing gaps in infrastructure and learning outcomes. We seek financial assistance to construct 10 classrooms, administrative offices, sanitation facilities, and a multipurpose hall, with essential learning materials and teacher training. Your support will help create a nurturing, safe, empowering and inclusive learning environment for vulnerable children who otherwise face barriers to quality education.

2.1. Origin and justification for the School Project



While Uganda has made progress achieving universal primary education, children from poor households, especially orphans, still face significant challenges in accessing quality learning. In the peri-urban areas of Entebbe, the rapid population growth has led to overcrowded public schools, while private schools remain unaffordable for many children. Many children still learn in temporary shelters, overcrowded classrooms, or travel long distances to reach school. The result is low school readiness, high dropout rates, and limited learning achievement. There is an urgent need for a new communitybased school that offers quality teaching, safe infrastructure, and inclusive access.

The Triple Anointing Foundation has worked in Nkumba Bufulu, Katabi Town Council communities, supporting vulnerable children with education, psychosocial support, and nutrition. The school started with 36 orphans in 2023 and currently has 280 learners. However,

the lack of a permanent, purpose-built school facility has limited our effort and ability to expand and sustain our impact. Therefore, after procuring land, we believe that the construction of a dedicated school will enable us to deliver structured, consistent, and high-quality education to the children we serve and most of whom are orphans, children from female-headed households, living in poverty.

3. Project goal and objectives

Overall Goal:

To provide a safe, inclusive, and permanent learning space for orphans and vulnerable children through the construction of a fully equipped primary school.

Specific project objectives

- 1. Construct and equip 10 classrooms from Early Childhood Development to Primary Seven.
- Establish child-friendly and gendersensitive water and sanitation facilities
- 3. Provide essential learning and teaching materials.
- Train and deploy qualified and compassionate teachers with a focus on child-friendly, inclusive teaching methods.
- Strengthen the school governance through parental and community involvement.



4. Project scope and description

The school will be constructed on a 50x100 site already secured by the Triple Anointing Foundation in Nkumba Bufulu, Katabi Town Council, Wakiso District. It will include:

- 1) 10 Classrooms: One for each level (Baby-P.7)
- 2) Administration Block: Headteacher's office, staffroom, and reception
- 3) Sanitation Facilities: Separate latrines for boys and girls, handwashing stations
- 4) Water Supply: Rainwater harvesting system and storage tanks
- 5) Multipurpose Hall: For assemblies, indoor learning, and community use
- 6) Playground: Safe recreational space
- 7) Perimeter Fence: To ensure safety and security



5. Target Beneficiaries

Over 500 children annually (ages 3–14), primarily orphans, vulnerable children, and those from low-income households, are directly benefiting from this initiative. Parents, guardians, caregivers, and the wider community are benefiting from improved access to education, child development, and local employment opportunities.

8. Our Sustainability Plan

The school is owned and operated by Triple Anointing Foundation, following a low-cost, community-supported model with modest school fees, sponsorships for

vulnerable children, and school-based income-generating activities such as agriculture or crafts. A School Management Committee and Parent-Teacher Association were established, and they ensure transparency, accountability, and long-term viability. Partnerships with Local Government and the Ministry of Education and Sports will strengthen alignment with national standards.

9. Monitoring and Evaluation

We will implement a results-based Monitoring and Evaluation framework with regular progress tracking and bi-annual reporting to donors. Key indicators include:

- 1. enrolment and attendance rates, and teacher retention
- 2. Academic performance and literacy levels
- 3. Infrastructure completion milestones
- 4. Feedback from parents, teachers, and learners

Progress reports will be submitted quarterly, and a final evaluation will assess impact and inform scale-up opportunities and will be shared with our donors.

10. Our request

We invite you to partner with us in shaping a brighter future for children in Entebbe. Your support will directly transform the lives of orphans and children from low-income households through access to quality education and dignified learning spaces. Your partnership will not only build a school but will also help nurture potential, restore hope, and create lasting change for hundreds of vulnerable children.
